

Helicopter crashes into a crane

Two people were killed and twelve were injured after a devastating incident when a helicopter crashed into a crane in central London.

On Wednesday 17th January at about 8:00 in the morning was the time that the helicopter had crashed into the crane.

The pilot, Captain Pete Barnes was sadly killed along with a man called Matthew Wood was on the ground. However, 12 people were injured during the crash.

Luckily there was a high possibility that an operator of the crane Nicki Biagioni would have also been killed during the accident if he had not been late. He said **“I can't believe it. If it wasn't for my boys not waking me up, that would have been it.”**

Captain Pete Barnes had been asked to be diverted to a nearby heliport due to the bad weather.

Cars and two buildings were caught on fire due to the flames of the helicopter; it took eighty fire fighters to be able to stop the fire happening any longer.

The eyewitness Andrew Beadle had said “I thought that it was a bomb.”

However, in respect to the very skilled pilot, tributes have paid for the unbelievable accident that had caused his death.
